oversee the Integrity Management Plan (IMP) and implementation of actions required to comply with Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) Part 192 Regulations.

Zamarin holds a Bachelor of Science Degree in Materials Engineering from Purdue University and a Master of Business Administration in Executive Management from the University of Houston.

Both Hutton and Zamarin will be based in Houston.
